Look Who's Talking: Speech, Language & Hearing Development (COK-Special Needs, 1.5hrs/Child Growth & Development, 1.5hrs) Knowing the appropriate developmental milestones of young children is an important component to preparing them for school success. In today's culturally diverse classrooms, it is more important than ever that educators not only provide language rich environments, but also that we are able to identify and respond to inconsistencies in a child's speech and language development. In this workshop, participants will gain knowledge, skills, and techniques for implementing developmentally appropriate practices that encourage communication and reinforce language development.

Giving young children another form of expression is essential to problem-solving skills that foster emotional well-being and self-esteem. Sign language is beneficial for all children and language backgrounds.

Language Sense: Promoting Language through Sensory Stimulation (COK-Curriculum, 1.5hrs / Child Growth & Development, 1.5 hrs) As a child experiences new and different textures, tastes, smells, sights, and sounds, cognitive development becomes rich and dynamic. In this engaging workshop, we will discuss how all children can benefit from using sensory stimulation to enhance language development.

Professional Roundtable for Montessori Educators (COK-Professionalism, 2.5hrs)
